When you hear news like the 6-fold increase in heroin related deaths, what do you think? Here's what I think, "I can do something about it!"

In 1999, I produced a TV show called *One Family's Battle*. We paid to have it broadcast it on 26 television stations in Oregon. Two years later the Oregon State Medical Examiner reported the number of heroin deaths were down but over 50%.

Is this a coincidence? You tell me. Several drug treatment centers told me the number of intake calls for heroin addiction doubled the day after the broadcast in at least one area.

I'm not bragging, just saying we can save so many of these loved people.

Today *One Family's Battle* is still helping people understand how dangerous heroin is and how it can affect all the people in their lives.

OK, I have to admit the show is a little dated, but like Jimmy Stewart's *It's a Wonderful Life*, *One Family's Battle* has withstanding the test of time.

If you want to make a difference, put this powerful story in front of as many people as you can. You could be saving their life because they will "get it!"

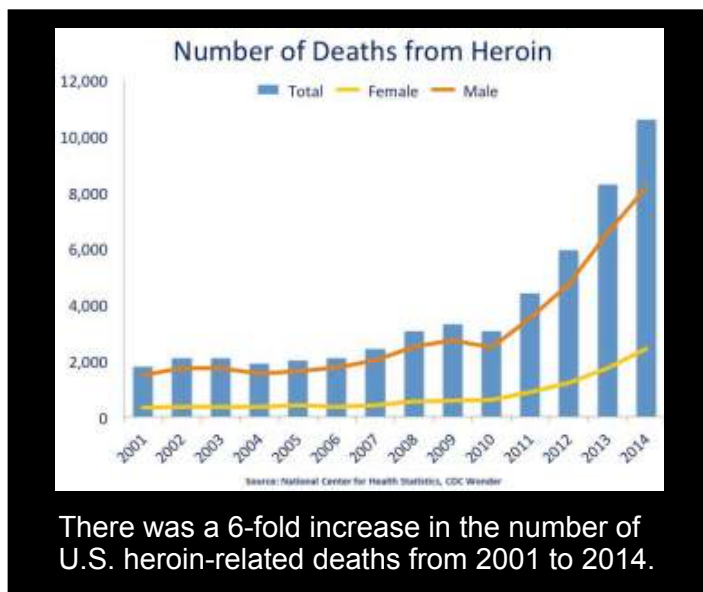
